## How to configure your Android device with Activesync

## **Introduction:**

The purpose of this documentation is to provide end users complete configuration steps in activating an Android powered device with our Hosted Exchange 2016 email services. In this example, a Samsung S6 plus was used.

Prerequisites:

- Android Device
- Subscribed to a Hosted Exchange 2016 account
- ActiveSync enabled on the mailbox

## **Steps:**

1. From the **settings** menu, choose the **accounts** icon.



2. Select "+ Add account" at the bottom.



3. Select Microsoft Exchange Activesync.



4. Enter in your FULL email address and mailbox password.
