## How to import a PST file to Outlook 2010, 2013, or 2016

## **Introduction:**

The purpose of this documentation is to provide end users complete configuration steps in importing a PST file to Outlook 2010, 2013, or 2016. Outlook 2013 on a PC was used in this example.

Prerequisites:

- A PST file with your old mailbox data
- Exchange account that has been configured
- Outlook 2010, Outlook 2013, Outlook 2016

## **Steps:**

1. From Outlook 2013, go to the **FILE** tab.



2. Select "Open & Export" on the left.



3. Select "Import/Export".



4. Choose "Import from another program or file" and select "Next".



5. Select "Outlook Data file (.pst)" and select "Next".



6. Browse for your backup PST file. Select "**Next**" to continue.
